

采购需求

一、采购项目概况

为更好的实现文明交流互鉴，满足观众对于高水平国际展览的需求，拟于2024年11月至2025年5月期间在首都博物馆本馆A厅举办“希腊人：从阿伽门农到亚历山大大帝”（暂定名）展览。计划展示270件（组）展品（36箱，约40立方），其中包括4件复制品、4件模型和2件石膏模型，展品总估价：EUR 66,090,400.00。

展品预计会分为两个批次从北京机场直飞雅典和法兰克福机场。境外段运输及归还等服务启动前，应与希腊馆方充分沟通并确定运输方案。

展品在首都博物馆展厅进行交接，投标人需负责北京海关进境延期手续办理，文物鉴定站延期手续办理和海关展览销案手续办理以及布展；展览结束后撤展，首都博物馆现场装货，出馆，机场送货，押运，出口报关，空运订舱回运，文物归还至希腊各出借单位等服务。除此以外，此次运输和展览期间，供应商应提供希腊馆方所派负责文物安全保障的随行人员布撤展及代表团所需全程往返直航国际机票、酒店、津贴、签证费、交通费用及人员旅行保险等。

二、项目特别说明

（1）预算金额：2,501,566.12元；

（2）费用包含：海关费、文物鉴定站延期手续办理费、布展和撤展费（含包装、搬运）、国内运输费（首都博物馆至北京机场，含押运费）、国际运输费（含押运费）、希腊方人员费用等。

（3）其中希腊方人员费预算金额共计625,244.40元，以实际发生为准，但最高不超过预算金额。

三、采购内容及要求

（1）主要采购内容：

采购内容为回程文物运输及人员押运点交相关费用，“希腊人”展览展品布撤展、运输及希腊方人员相关费用，内容包括：本项目展览开展前布展，展览结束后首都博物馆至北京机场装卸运输，北京空运至雅典国际机场和法兰克福机场、境内外机场监督、境外机场提货，境外机场运至希腊馆方的回运事宜，相关关务手续，希腊馆方布/撤展组人员及代表团人员津贴、机票、期间四星级酒店住宿、

签证费及旅行险及希腊境内转运展品发生的希腊馆方人员津贴、交通、住宿费用等。

服务过程中，供应商须接受采购人及希腊馆方工作人员现场监督。对于不适宜包装运输移动的展品，采购人同供应商共同研究商讨制定专门的包装运输方案。

1. 包装运输方案包括但不限于：

- 1) 布、撤展及包装方案；
- 2) 运输、装卸方案；
- 3) 与各方配合和协调措施；
- 4) 拟投入设备及专用工具；
- 5) 实施进度和计划；
- 6) 安全措施及应急预案；
- 7) 供应商认为需要提供的其它说明和资料。

2. 运输服务内容：计划展示 270 件（套）来自希腊馆方的雕塑、陶器及金属器等展品（展品内容详见附件 1：《希腊人：从阿伽门农到亚历山大大帝》（暂定名）展品目录估价表）。

3. 运输路线包括首都博物馆至北京机场陆运、北京机场到境外机场的回程空运、境外机场至希腊馆方指定地点的回程陆运。

4. 境外段运输及归还等服务启动前，应与希腊馆方充分沟通并确定运输方案。

5. 包装情况：使用展品入境时使用的包装箱、填充物等，如需补充需符合文物运输标准及希腊馆方要求。

6. 希腊馆方来华人员费用包括：希腊馆方所派负责文物安全保障的押运和布撤展人员、参加开幕式的希腊馆方代表等工作人员所需全程往返直航国际机票、酒店、津贴、签证费、交通费用及人员旅行保险及希腊境内转运展品发生的希腊馆方人员津贴、交通、住宿费用等。

6.1 津贴：按照采购人标准执行。

6.2 酒店：四星级及以上酒店（须具备外宾接待能力），距离首都博物馆步行路程 10-15 分钟。

6.3 机票：代表团为商务舱机票。

(2) 整体服务内容：

1. 投标人须具有自行办理国内、国际运输（陆运、空运）全部手续的能力。
2. 在海关清关方面有充分的经验，可提供支持采购人完成文物及布展物料的海关延期、文物复出境等。
3. 文物在中国境内的运输由投标人执行。
4. 文物在中国境外的运输，投标人应与希腊馆方充分沟通并确定运输方案。
5. 供应商在所有文物钉到钉的运输过程中须做好保密和防范措施，运输的路线、时间、地点的知情人要控制在最小范围内，文物全程运输过程中，都应有专业安保押运人员或借展方认可的工作人员随行押运，负责运输过程中的安全保卫。做到人不离物，物不离人，以高度的责任心保证文物的安全。确保所有文物不出现物品灭失、短少、变质、污染、损坏等情况，若在运输过程中因供应商操作不当导致上述情况发生，供应商须承担相应的赔偿责任。
6. 工作人员工作中具有良好的精神面貌和工作态度。
7. 供应商须派专人在项目实施过程中，及时向采购人提供服务过程中的各项信息反馈。
8. 负责文物安全保障的随行人员布撤展及代表团所需全程往返直航国际机票、酒店、津贴、签证费、交通费用及人员旅行保险及希腊境内转运展品发生的希腊馆方人员津贴、交通、住宿费用等。
9. 供应商应具备解决突发状况的能力，确保文物按时，安全抵达，按质按量完成布撤展，确保准时开展及闭展。
10. 供应商应使用封闭式空调卡车（由专业文物运输公司提供，配备空气悬挂装置和全球定位系统跟踪）进行陆运，并提供境外武装护送及中国境内安保护送。

（3）包装及运输要求

1. 根据采购人提出的时间要求，制定具体运输操作计划，按时、保质完成运输工作。
2. 同希腊馆方沟通确认在希腊当地的运输事宜，并全程监督展品在运输和装卸过程中安全。
3. 陆运车辆必须为自有车辆，并符合文物、艺术品安全运输要求，需配有减震气垫、温控设备及电动升降尾板的专业运输车辆，均符合国家法律法规及车辆

型号，提供道路运输许可证、行驶证，车辆配备可视化监控系统（车厢内及车厢外）、GPS 定位系统、安全中心控制室监控，手机实时监控。

4. 国际空运应安排机坪、库区监督，并应选用宽体飞机进行空运。

5. 展品运输期间须按事先计划的、采购人认可的路线行驶，期间不得以任何原因改变运输计划，如发生意外情况，需临时停留，需派出专人看守文物。

6. 文物运输车辆须配备货仓空调和气压减震装置，舱门可以上锁，并配有干粉灭火器。配备至少 2 辆运输车，每辆运输车随车司机 2 人和至少随车押运人员 1 人；安保车辆 2 台，每台配备押运人员 2 人；2 辆小车供外方团队跟车押运至机场。

7. 针对特殊尺寸、重量的大型文物，提供专门的搬运设备和运输预案。

8. 为保障文物安全，协助展品操作的人员必须是经验丰富的专业人员。

9. 根据展品外包装箱尺寸，提前制作合理装车图，以避免多次装卸对展品造成伤害。展品必须轻拿轻放；在搬运前确认沿途没有障碍物，防止展品在搬运途中跌落、破损。展品装卸时一般采用人工操作；人工操作时必须保持箱体平衡。

10. 不得对“展品”包装箱进行任何特殊标注（除装箱单标签）、涂画或改变内部布局。

11. 供应商应在展品运输前，向采购人提供一份中文文物装箱清单。

（4）布/撤展要求

在展览开展前及展览闭幕后，首都博物馆专家与希腊馆方专家进行文物点交，供应商由展台取出展品，包装后放入到包装箱，完成封箱工作。全部包装材料的设计、使用均需符合《文物运输包装规范》（GB/T 23862-2009）等要求。需具备本项目所必须的设备和专业操作工具。对特殊文物，如超重、特殊包装文物提前制定采购人认可的可行性方案。

（5）相关服务要求

1. 签订运输协议，尽快落实安排文物运输等事宜。

2. 提供详细的展品运输计划，包括展品运输时间以及详细操作程序。

3. 所有展品清关，含报关、报检、查验、文物鉴定等。

4. 参与布撤展服务的相关人员，具有文物布撤展经验，开箱点交后由供应商负责安装布展，在整个布撤展期间内供应商须安排专门的技术人员驻现场服务

（布撤展时要具备的工具列表详见附件 2 布撤展工具及设备列表的内容。供应商需根据项目需求提供相应的布撤展工具及设备，包括但不限于附件 2 布撤展工具及设备列表的内容。

5. 布撤展现场专人办公，人数足够的专门团队跟进，中途不能随意调换人员。

6. 展览结束后，将文物运回至文物所属方，协助其开箱查验，查验后按文物所属方要求将文物存放至指定区域或库房内。

7. 供应商需在服务期间按时回复首都博物馆相关负责人的任何书面要求，不得超过 1 个工作日。

8. 供应商应具备专业技术人员和包装运输工具的服务能力。

（6）项目团队要求

投标人针对本项目提供专业的项目团队：

1. 项目负责人 1 人；

2. 布撤展团队 8 人；

3. 运输团队配备至少 2 辆运输车，每辆运输车随车司机 2 人和至少随车押运人员 1 人；安保车辆 2 台，每台配备押运人员 2 人；2 辆小车供外方团队跟车押运至机场。

四、采购项目实施的时间、地点

1. 时间：2024 年 10 月至 2025 年 7 月；根据采购人提出的时间要求，在展览开始前 30 日内及闭幕前 15 日内，制定具体回程操作计划，并提供至采购人确认。

2. 地点：首都博物馆、北京及境外国际机场、希腊馆方和采购人指定地点。

3. 如展览因不可抗力的因素延期举办，配套的通关及协助撤展工作时间应相应进行调整，双方友好协商解决。

五、法律政策规定

1. 行业资质管理：《中华人民共和国国家标准 GB/T23862-2009 文物运输包装规范》、《展览物流服务基本要求-GB/T 36682-2018》、《国际植物检疫措施标准》（ISPM15 标准）、《中华人民共和国文物保护法》、《中华人民共和国文物保护法实施条例》、《文物进出境审核管理办法》、《文物出境鉴定管理办法》、《文物出境展览管理规定》、《出国（境）文物展品包装工作规范》等。

2. 国家安全和秘密：《中华人民共和国保守国家秘密法》。
3. 劳动法保护：《中华人民共和国劳动法》。

六、验收标准

展览结束后，供应商应将文物运回至文物所属方，采购人根据本项目的服务需求及供应商提出的服务方案进行验收。

1. 履约验收主体：首都博物馆；
2. 履约验收时间：希腊馆方签收后；
3. 履约验收方式：自行组织验收；
4. 履约验收程序：展览布展结束后依据对合同服务条款对供应商服务进行验收；

5. 履约验收内容：

5.1 签订展览施行所必须的合同，支付国际运费、国内运费及希腊馆方所派负责文物安全保障的押运和布撤展人员、参加开幕式的希腊馆方代表等工作人员所需的全程往返直航国际机票、酒店、津贴、签证费、交通费用及人员旅行保险及希腊境内转运展品发生的希腊馆方人员津贴、交通、住宿费用等；

5.2 按照约定时间将展品运到甲方指定地点；

5.3 需提供符合文物运输安全的木箱包装及加固、符合文物运输的正规车辆、航空包板运输并经希腊馆方相关人员认可；

5.4 负责办理运输的全部手续及协调疏通工作；

5.5 协助文物点交、文物交接、布撤展,布撤展期间项目负责人需全程驻现场，每天至少 8 名专业人员办公，中途不得随意更换人员，如有人员变动需经甲方同意。

6. 履约验收标准：完成以上验收内容为合格，未完成则为不合格；




